>>>Cub Scout Religious Emblems---Light of Christ and Parvuli Dei. If your Cub Scout has completed one of these emblems, you will need to send the Emblem Application form to: PhxDCCS; C/O Reverend Dennis J. O'Rourke, PhxDCCS Chaplain; St. Gabriel the Archangel Catholic Church; 32648 N. Cave Creek Rd, Cave Creek, AZ 85331-5540 Please include a check for \$15 per medal made payable to "PhxDCCS". The Light of Christ Emblem Application can be found at the back of the book on page 55-56. The Parvuli Dei form is located in the book on page 51-52. The medal should be presented at a parish mass or other appropriate venue. If this is the first emblem your Cub Scout has earned, he is eligible to wear the purple knot on his uniform. These can be purchased at the Scout Shop and should be presented at a Pack meeting. There is also a tiny pin called a "device" that can be purchased and is pinned on the purple knot to indicate that the scout earned the religious emblem at a certain level. For example, for Light of Christ the device has the Wolf symbol and for Parvuli Dei it is the Webelos symbol. A tip---put a dab of hot glue or tacky glue on the back of those device pins before putting the fastener on...they will stay more securely!
